- 5. Agenda no. SAC/06/11 Approval of purchase of library software He was informed that software's like UpToDate, EMBASE, SCOPUS, Clinical Key Etc. have already been made functional in the institutional library.
- 6. Agenda no. SAC/06/14 Discontinuation of M.Sc. Medical Course Dr. Prasad recommended that the decision be reconsidered. All the member agreed that these courses should be discontinued as even the NMC does not recognise them as teachers.
- 7. SAC/06/17.3 In principle approval for engagement of Visiting faculty at AIIMS Gorakhpur, Dr. Prasad mentioned that we should make an active effort to engage Faculty not only from India but also abroad. He also mentioned tie ups with Cleveland clinic association, Lausanne University, Switzerland etc. It was informed by Executive Director that payment beyond the approved Honorarium of 5000/- Rupees is not permissible as per rules, but if there is any change in guidelines the same would be considered. So, any visiting faculty would be paid as per norms, if workshop/lecture is delivered in person.

Regarding DM Pain Medicine the members were of the view that a PDF course in this category was more feasible considering the experience of single faculty of Assistant Professor level.DM course in the same can be considered after the PDF is successfully conducted for few years.
