Instructions for M.Sc. Nursing Candidates Allotted Seats – 2026 Session

Date: 8.08.2026

- The reporting dates and time shall be as decided by AIIMS New Delhi
- Fees shall be deposited in the form of demand draft in favour of “AIIMS GORAKHPUR” payable at Gorakhpur/ Online. The amount of fees is Rs 2465/-. Candidates need to mention the name, roll no, rank and course name on the demand draft.
- **Academic session is scheduled to start from 27th August, 2026. Hostel Allotment shall be done from 26th August from 10 am onwards.**
- As the candidates need to get their medical examination, candidates should ensure their availability for the next day also, if required.
- The list of documents which needs to be submitted at the time of reporting are Admit card issued by AIIMS, Final Registration Slip, offer letter, Seat allotment letter, Date of birth certificate, 10th class marks card and certificate, 12th class marks card and certificate, Proof of Identity card, valid Caste certificate / EWS certificate (if applicable), Degree/provisional/passing Certificate of B.Sc. (Hons.) Nursing/ B.Sc. Nursing (Post-certificate)/Post-Basic/B.Sc. Nursing (4 years). Mark-sheet of the qualifying examination, Certificate of Registration as Nurse & Midwife (RN/RM) with any State Nursing Council, Migration certificate, Disability certificate (if applicable), self-attested copies of all original documents, and any other certificate deemed necessary.
- Unauthorised absence of students will be informed to the Students and also to their parents or Local Guardians. At least 3 reminders will be issued with a gap of 10 days by the Academic Section to these students. Thereafter, the action of cancellation of the registration of the concerned will be decided by the Dean Academics/ Executive Director, AIIMS Gorakhpur.
- All admitted students must submit an undertaking at the time of admission. It must state that the candidate is aware that M.Sc. Nursing is a full-time course, and they are not/will not enroll in any other course/job during their study period at AIIMS Gorakhpur. The student must agree not to take leave without permission and to follow all institutional and hostel rules.
- The verification process and other formalities might take some time, and there is a possibility that it might spill over to the next day. Hence, candidates are advised to plan accordingly.
